Directions

- 1. Dust mop floor
- 2. Dilute 1 1/2 oz.-2 oz. of Gloss Restorer to 1 Us Gallon of water.
- 3. Damp Mop, for large areas use an auto scrubber
- 4. Let Dry

Mop Restoration and Cleaning Applications

- 1. Dust mop floor
- 2. Dilute 3-4 oz. of Gloss Restorer with 1 US Gallon water.
- 3. Use a clean mop, apply solution to the floor in the same manner as damp mopping.
- 4. Allow to sit for 3-5 minutes, then pickup solution
- 5. Allow to dry, then burnish with natural hair pad.

Spray Buff Restoration

- 1. Dust mop floor
- 2. Dilute 12 oz. of Gloss Restorer to 1 US gallon of water.
- 3. Liberally apply ahead of buffer and spray buff to a high gloss.


Auto Scrubber Restoration

- 1. Dilute 3-4 oz. of Gloss Restorer with 1 Us gl of water.
- 2. Scrub with a red pad on a double pass procedure. Scrub only on the first (do not pickup) and then on the second pass, pick up only, do not scrub. The longer the solution sits between pauses
- 3. Allow to dry
- 4. Burnish with floor machine and burnishing pad

Caution: Keep from freezing
