ICE MELT FACTS

How much should I use? Depending on thickness of ice, evenly spread 2-4 ounces (1/4 to ½ cup) per square yard. Allow product to work to melt the bond between the ice & surface. Remove melted ice, snow and slush to prevent re-freezing. By removing the product along with the snow, you will eliminate tracking and all that's left is a safe, clean surface.

Are products safe to use around animals? When ice melters are applied in accordance with the directions on the bag, our products are safe to use around animals.

Are products safe to use around my vegetation? Ice melters are safe to use around vegetation when the directions on the bag are followed.

How do I avoid damage to concrete?? Freeze/thaw cycles are a naturally occurring event that can put added pressure on concrete. To reduce additional freeze/thaw cycles and the risk of flaking, quickly remove the slush that results from the melted ice and snow. In doing this, you are also removing the possibility of additional freeze/thaw cycles.
